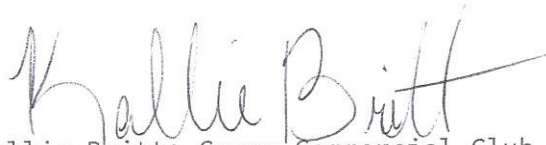
AHF Consultants will be having their ribbon cutting on August 1st at 11am. The Franklin County Chamber of Commerce will be hosting but we ask
